

# How Manistee Area Public Schools launched their journey to success



## CHALLENGE

Manistee Area Public Schools, a Minnesota district serving preschool through grade 12, faced challenges in assessment and effective teacher collaboration.

Test scores revealed gaps in student mastery, indicating a lack of clarity in defining learning outcomes. In addition, collaboration among high school teachers proved problematic. Teachers, often isolated in single-subject roles, lacked structured time for meaningful teamwork.

## IMPLEMENTATION

A desire to improve sparked Manistee’s transformation to become a Professional Learning Communities (PLC) at Work® district. This journey began with leaders attending **The Summit on PLC at Work**, where they gained strategies and tools to inspire meaningful change.

Building on the summit’s insights, Manistee launched a multi-year effort to embed PLC practices districtwide. Leaders established a guiding coalition, developed a shared mission and vision, and created dedicated collaboration time for teachers.

Staff engaged in book studies, professional learning and coaching to refine assessment design, strengthen intervention systems and build a supportive school culture. These efforts produced stronger collaboration, more consistent instruction and measurable improvements in student outcomes across the district.


## RESULTS

Through this ongoing journey, Manistee successfully integrated assessment into its PLC framework, creating a more data-driven, responsive learning environment.

Student achievement improved significantly from 2020–21 to 2023–24:

- Kindergarten Math: 69% → 82%
- 3rd Grade English: 26.2% → 45.7%
- 6th Grade English: 34.1% → 45.6%
